Introducing Whisper

Whisper is an anonymous reporting tool developed by the online safety charity SWGfL, designed to support reporting concerns in schools and organisations.

With secure, two-way communication, Whisper allows anyone in the community to report concerns in confidence to a trusted adult.

Who Uses Whisper?

- Hundreds of schools and organisations across the UK and internationally.
- Used by:
 - Students & young people
 - Staff members
 - Parents & carers



Who Manages Whisper?

- Schools and organisations subscribe to the tool
- They then assign a trusted staff member (often a Designated Safeguarding Lead) to manage and respond to reports.

How It Works

- Provides an open channel for anonymous reporting
 Secure 2-way communication via chat or SMS
- Reporting Forms
- Customisable settings for staff to segment and manage reports
